AIRCRAFT FLYING OVER THE TOWN OF NIPAWIN

Nipawin, Saskatchewan – July 16, 2018

Notice: The Town of Nipawin has received a number of concerns from residents about aircraft flying over the town and within the town boundaries. Please be advised that Transport Canada, which is the federal government agency that oversees aviation activities throughout Canada, has confirmed aircraft **are permitted** to fly over the town. Because the location of the town is in such close proximity to the airport, aircraft that are in the process of taking off or landing may fly over town at elevations of less than 1,000 feet, provided the aircraft is doing so safely. All other aircraft are required to maintain a minimum elevation of 1,000 feet over the highest obstacle.
