## **Town of Nipawin Passes Bylaw to Control the Use and Access of Alleys Throughout the Town of Nipawin Between the Hours of 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.**

*Nipawin, Saskatchewan – November 24, 2022*

At the November 14<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Council of the Town of Nipawin, Council passed Bylaw No. 1157/22, a Bylaw to Control the Use and Access of Alleys Throughout the Town of Nipawin between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. The Bylaw is deemed necessary to “temporarily restrict access to all alleys throughout the Town ... for the purposes of public safety”.

The bylaw provides for exemptions to the restrictions, including but not limited to permanent residents accessing their residences which may abut the alley, owners or employees of a business premise who are actively or imminently to be engaged in their employment duties, those who may be working for a utility agency which requires access to that alley, in an emergency situation, or to access a parking area in relation to a person’s own vehicular transportation.

The Bylaw may be enforced by a Bylaw Enforcement Officer or by the RCMP and tickets may be issued.
